NextAid Overview

NextAid's mission is to create and promote community-driven environmentally, economically and socially empowering responses to the AIDS orphan pandemic.

We collaborate with individuals, businesses and nonprofits to produce culturally-rich, awareness-raising projects and music events involving technology, the arts, public education projects, and volunteer opportunities. Through grass-roots efforts, NextAid provides opportunities for concerned entities to make a tangible difference in the lives of African children in need.

While the need is huge, and overall strategies are complex and difficult to implement, NextAid sees a clear place of engagement for deep and lasting impact, serving the children of this crisis by harnessing the power of music and activating a young demographic here in the U.S. into tangible action.

The Need: African Children and AIDS

We are dealing with the greatest health crisis in history. There are now over 40 million people living with AIDS. Of the 12.3 million children who have been left behind in the wake of AIDS, 95% are in Africa alone, and every 14 seconds another child is faced with losing his or her parent and taking on adult responsibilities because of AIDS.



Children are being taken out of school to care for relatives and because of unaffordable schooling costs. As education becomes scarce, children are becoming even more vulnerable. Knowledge is not being transferred from one generation to the next and is therefore lost while the traditional social service system of the extended family is broken. As HIV prevalence levels rise, poverty deepens. Africa is dealing with a multitude of integrated seemingly insurmountable challenges never before experienced in the history of the world. We must step in!

Our Response: The Youth With A Vision Community Center and Residential Village, Dennilton, South Africa

NextAid's premier project is a multi-purpose village for *Youth with a Vision (YWAV)*, partner South African non-profit organization. YWAV runs various programs to engage community members of all ages in changing the problems that affect their community. The teenagers use creative enterprise to teach AIDS awareness and life skills.

NextAid's commitment to YWAV is to provide design services, building know-how, training, and funding for the construction of the village on the 9-acre site. In addition, NextAid is helping YWAV build administrative capacity and source funding to run the programs that will operate out of the structures NextAid is committed to building. Under the supervision of lead ecological architect Joseph Kennedy, in partnership with Architecture for Humanity, and the local community, and with a team of international volunteer architects and natural builders we have created a plan to accommodate 50 children in 9 homes, provide a resource center for the larger community and a hub for economic enterprise. The projects and programs will serve as models for other sustainable endeavors NextAid plans to support and implement throughout the continent.



Sustainable Development

Sustainable development is a strategy of serving human needs while supporting the ecological foundation upon which all life depends. By fostering solutions rooted in sustainable development, NextAid supports ecologically sound growth, while balancing social and economic needs.

NextAid recognizes that simply providing buildings or traditional financial aid for the children is not sufficient. A thriving community support system, complete with after-school education, organic gardens and permaculture, counseling and social services, economic opportunities and recreational programs are needed to provide the best opportunities for these children to reach their individual and collective potential.

Beats Build Hope

NextAid is committed to activate young people in the U.S. through urban music culture to embrace hope, volunteer, give back, and make a tangible difference! NextAid has raised over \$400,000 since the start of the project in 2004. Our primary sources of funding have been from events, donations made by businesses catering to this niche demographic and individuals. We also fundraise through innovative channels such as online auctions and CD sales and have a strong volunteer force.

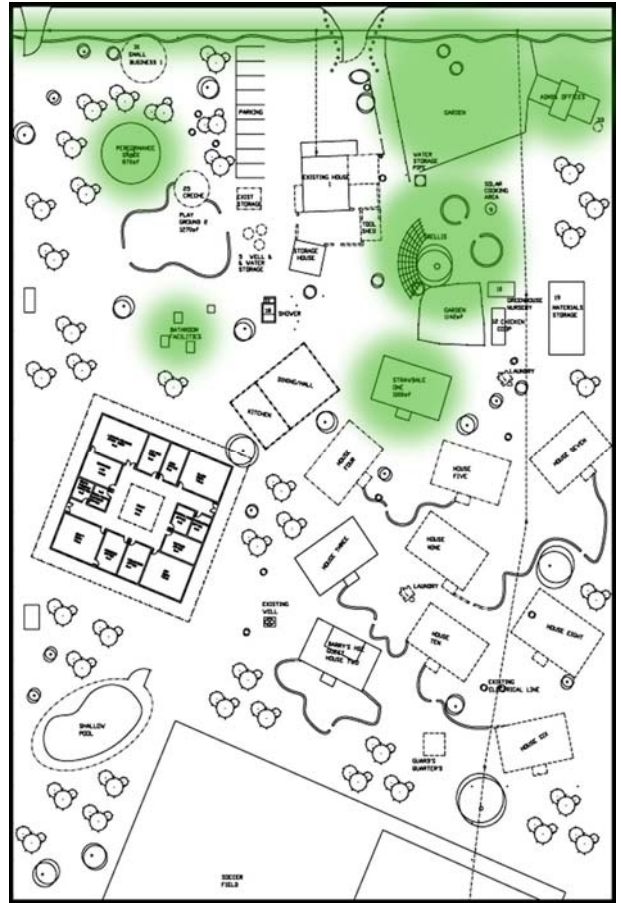
Phase one of construction saw the completion of:

As we enter phase two, the Adopt-a-Project program is a crucial piece of our ongoing strategy to finance the completion of the village. We have isolated various structures throughout the village and are offering the opportunity to sponsor their construction. The cause-marketing benefits for participating businesses are many-fold.



NextAid is able to customize a recognition program based on the needs and desires of the participating business. We will provide creatively designed signage on the structure itself acknowledging your contribution as well as mentions on our website, in press materials, and on partners' websites as well. Donors will be able to witness the progress by receiving photos and eventually making a visit! Buildings "up for adoption" include the main center's separate rooms and offices, dining hall, nursery school and day-care center, guesthouse, and 3 children's homes (for 6 kids and a care-taker). Sponsorship fees range from \$5,000 to \$110,000.

Adopt-a-Project



1. Main Center - \$5,000 - \$110,000 USD

The main center will serve as the focal point for child and adult education and enrichment programs. The structure will include the following:

2. Preschool/Nursery Day Care Center - \$25,000 USD

The structure will provide a warm and secure space for children from infancy to pre-school age. It will serve children living on-site and children of the center’s staff who may bring their children to work. It will also give limited general care for off-site families.



3. Playground - \$15,000 USD (Co-sponsored by DubSpot, NYC)

The playground will assist in attracting new children to the area, boosting enrollment in the after school programs. It will be connected to the Preschool/Nursery Day Care Center.



4. Security Guard House (1 room studio) - \$6,000 USD

This structure will first be a residence of the security guard. It is also an example of a simple one room house easily built by local residents.

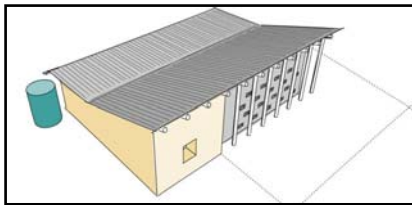
**5. Internet Café and Tuck Shop – \$10,000 USD
(Sponsored by the Grace Jones Richardson Trust)**

This structure will provide a space to operate a roadside business, generating income for the center's programs and staff with a Tuck Shop (goods and snacks) and Internet Café.



6. Children's Home 2 - \$23,000 USD

This home will provide a family structured shelter and sanctuary for six children and one to two caregivers. This home includes three bedrooms, a loft, a living room, and a full bathroom. Just one home can serve dozens if not hundreds of children over the course of its lifetime.



7. Children's Home 3 "Hybrid House" – \$23,000 USD

This home will provide a family structured shelter and sanctuary for six children and one to two caregivers. This home includes four bedrooms, a living room, and a full bathroom. Just one home care serve dozens if not hundreds of children over the course of its lifetime.



8. Guesthouse - \$25,000 USD

The guesthouse will provide lodging for up to eight guests who will be volunteers working with the local community or visiting eco-tourists who will rent lodging.
